As the play unfolds, the characters pursue their own agendas, frustrating the others ambitions but rarely achieving their own, in a bleakly humorous look at human folly. Famous for its clever dialogue and insightful characterization, The Seagull is one of Chekhov s best-known plays, and is essential reading for anyone interested in theater or Russian literature.
